
Spending time together.

Maintaining a warm and responsive relationship (bond) between parent or caregiver and child promotes healthy social, emotional, and brain development.

Hello READY! Parents & Caregivers, Here are several everyday ways you can help nurture your child's social and emotional development:

- Talk and listen to your little one. Talk out loud about what you are doing, seeing, hearing, and thinking during the day. Toddlers "talk" using many sounds, gestures, and actions. When he or she babbles, talk back. Show excitement when your child begins to say words.
- Read, play and explore together. Be actively involved it's the best way to learn and build relationships at any age. Explore outside. Consider the child's interests and personality when choosing activities. Young children need physical activity every day ... and so do adults.



- Make eye contact; smile. Facial expressions show children they are loved and cherished. Attentive eye contact and a warm, adoring smile builds a child's sense of confidence, self-worth, and security. If this doesn't come naturally, make a conscious effort to slow down and focus on your child.
- Be consistent; establish routines. Toddlers are happiest when life is predictable and they know what to expect. Provide meals and snacks on regular schedule. Establish routines for daily events.
- Assure child feels safe. Always supervise a toddler. Be alert to safety hazards and health issues. Pay extra attention to keeping your home baby-proofed for a child who walks and climbs. Respect your child's feelings of distress and separation anxiety; comfort and stay near when your child is afraid; stay close and calm during a tantrum.
